Jeremiah 7:1–11, 21–23 Application

1. The LORD wanted as many as possible to hear His words, repent, and return to obeying His voice. Think of ways you and your Church can reach more people, so they can hear the good news about Jesus and turn to Him. Pray for the Lord to lead you next week to help at least one more person?
2. Think about what deeds and ways you need to amend and pray for Jesus to help you so you can dwell closer to Him day-by-day. Ask Him, “What is one change I need to make today and the days after that? Please help me.”
3. Do not trust in deceptive words, such as, “I go to church, I go to church, I go to church,” BUT, do go to church and learn more from the Bible so the Holy Spirit can help you amend your ways and deeds and bless others.
4. Think of some ways you and your church can *truly* help the sojourner, the fatherless, or the widow near you or your church. Plan a way to do so.
5. Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life, think about and share at least one way your life is better because He has helped You follow Him. Think of a way you might encourage someone next week; pray and plan to do so.
