2 Chronicles 30:1-9, 26-27 Application

1. Though there may be animosity, ill-will, or even hatred between some persons or groups, they may still be able to gather in the House of the LORD, which might enable them to draw closer to the Lord Jesus, learn more from the Bible, and by His grace reconcile as He leads and intends.
2. Strong leaders in any job who serve the Lord Jesus Christ can pray, seek the Lord's will, and ask the Holy Spirit to help them lead a nation or an individual to a living faith in the true God. We need to pray for such leaders in our homes, churches, places of education and work, and nation.
3. As followers of the Lord Jesus Christ, we need to consecrate and reconsecrate ourselves to serving Jesus each day, so we are ready as an individual or with others to serve the Lord when He calls.
4. The Bible, and especially the commandments and teachings of Jesus, prescribe how the followers of Jesus should live and worship together.
5. The Bible shows and teaches that God will discipline those who remain faithless and become stiff-necked when called to repent and return to God.
