Genesis 22:1-14 Application

- 1. The Bible shows that when God gives a promise, He keeps His promise.
- 2. Faith includes trusting in God; no matter what our circumstances God always finds a way to keep all His promises.
- 3. God sometimes tests us to help us grow in our knowledge of God and of ourselves, and in faith in God and God's Word.
- 4. God forbids child sacrifices. Jesus, the Son of God, knowingly and willing came into the world as a human being to die as a sacrifice for the forgiveness of our sins. He knew He could lay down His life and take it up again. No one took His life from Him. He lived, died, and rose again for us.
- 5. God is the same yesterday, today, and forever, and the LORD God has promised to provide all that His children really need; therefore, we can always trust in God.
