Application — Five Takeaways February 19, 2017 Galatians 5:1-17

- 1. Jesus Christ set those who believe in Him free from slavery to sin and Satan, so they could be free, not fall back into slavery, or use their freedom to indulge the flesh.
- 2. If a person begins to or continues to trust in religious rules and ceremonies to be saved, then Jesus Christ will be of no value to them.
- 3. By faith in Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit, believers in Jesus hope for righteousness to live right and to be judged righteous by God.
- 4. What counts is expressing our faith through love for God and others; therefore, we should love our neighbors as we love ourselves and walk by the Spirit.
- 5. Those who intentionally confuse others about the truth of the Scriptures and the good news of Jesus Christ will have a penalty to pay.
